Park Location	Trail Name	General Description	Difficulty
Blue Spruce Park	<i>Getty Run</i>	This trail has numerous grassy paths that follow a small stream at the upper end of the lake, begins at playground.	E
	<i>Dusky (formerly Swinging Bridge)</i>	A loop trail located in a ravine area. Name for Dusky Salamander species located in this area.	E
	<i>Aspen Trail</i>	The trail follows the southern ridge of park.	M
	<i>PCC (PA Conservation Corps)</i>	A spur off the Aspen Trail that completes a circle higher up the park's southern ridge.	M
	<i>Trillium</i>	A short trail that connects to the Aspen Trail. Begins across the road from the park playground.	M
	<i>Vista Ridge</i>	This trail follows the park's northern ridge.	M
	<i>Overlook</i>	Begins at the large parking lot on northern side of lake.	M
	Pine Ridge Park	<i>Tom's Run</i>	A loop trail located on the ridge above Tom's Run.
<i>Lodge Trail</i>		A steep climb to the top of the ridge circling back to the park day use area. Passes near Pine Lodge.	H
Blacklick Valley Natural Area	<i>Parker Lane</i>	All of the trails at the BVNA, except for the Collier Trail, are located in a forested floodplain, wetland area along	E
	<i>Wetlands</i>	Blacklick Creek. The Collier Trail is located on the ridge	E
	<i>Blacklick Creek</i>	high above the other trails. All trails are accessed	E
	<i>Candlestick</i>	from the parking lot located on McFeater's Road, off of	E
	<i>Connector</i>	Route 22.	H

	<i>Wood Duck</i>	A loop trail beginning at the park's western access area.	E
Buttermilk Falls	<i>McFeely</i>	A loop trail located in a wooded area. A separate pathway leads to the falls viewing area.	M
Old Smicksburg Park	<i>Village Streets</i>	Trails consist of grassy pathways located on former streets of this historic village.	E
Waterworks Conservation Area	<i>Wetlands</i>	A short trail encircles the wetlands on the property.	E
