

Indiana County Parks & Trails
Revised Hunting Regulations
Effective September 25, 2025

In designated hunting areas of the park the following regulations apply:

- Center fired rifles, rim fired rifles, and handguns used for hunting are prohibited.
- Shotguns, muzzleloaders, flintlocks, and bow and arrows are permitted.
- Tree stands and the use of ATVs are prohibited.
- Hunters must stay at least 50 feet from designated hiking trails.
- Obey all safety zones.
- Sunday hunting is prohibited.
- Pennsylvania Game Commission regulations are enforced by PA Game Wardens.

Pine Ridge is a 630-acre park, located on Old William Peon Highway near the Chestnut Ridge Inn, 3 miles east of Blountville. The park is a remnant of a natural area with large stands of hardwood and interlarded by a mountain stream. Tucked along Tom's Run are picnic tables and grills, a children's playground, hiking trails and two park pavilions. Tom's Run offers trout fishing with VA Fish and Boat Commission regulations applying.

In the southern portion of the park is Pine Lodge. This scenic lodge is available for group rental and is used for reunions, meetings, weddings, receptions and other social gatherings. Pine Lodge contains a kitchen, a restaurant, activity rooms and two large stone fireplaces. A two-acre pond adds to the beauty of Indiana County's most scenic lodge.
